- AN INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE APPRAISAL
- PANEL QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

Workshop 2 (10th Oct) will provide an introduction to the technical aspects of performing in front of a live audience and will include:

- USING SOUND EQUIPMENT
- STARTING THE SHOW
- ENDING THE SHOW
- INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE OF A SONG OR PIECE OF MUSIC
- INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE APPRAISAL
- PANEL QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

Workshop 3 (17th Oct) will further develop performance skills and will include:

- DEVELOPING YOUR OWN STYLE AND PERFORMANCE COMMUNICATION SKILLS
